Adult Telehealth Consultations

We offer telehealth consultations for patients with Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C. If you would like to refer a patient for a different condition, please send your request along with the patient's chart notes to the telehealth coordinator for the specialist's consideration.

Current Management of Hepatitis B and Hepatitis C

Necessary Clinical Information

- Chemistry 20 panel, including liver function tests
- CBC and INR within past three months
- History and physical completed within past six months
- AFP (Alpha Feto Protein) • Hepatitis C Antibody
- HBsAb • Hepatitis A IgG

Additional Tests for Hepatitis B Patients

- HBV-DNA, HBcAb (total) • HBeAg, HBeAb, HBsAg

Additional Tests for Hepatitis C Patients

- Hepatitis C viral load (RNA) • Hepatitis C genotype

Information to Provide (If Available)

- Liver biopsy reports • CT or ultrasound reports
- Colonoscopy, sigmoidoscopy or endoscopy reports
- Any discharge summaries for the past year
- HIV status

Information Needed Prior to Scheduling an Appointment

- [Telehealth Referral Request Form](#)
- All necessary clinical information as listed above
- Patient questionnaire (for hypoparathyroid referrals)

Information Needed Before the Consultation Begins

- Signed [UC Davis Health Acknowledgement of Receipt: Notice of Privacy Practices](#) form (new patients only)
- Documented verbal consent from the patient for participation in a telehealth consultation

Appointment Scheduling

New: 45-60 minutes

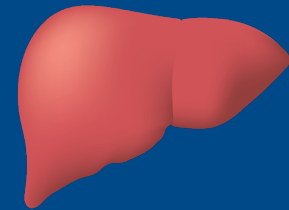
Follow-up: 30 minutes
